RCOM statement on the Hon'ble Supreme Court judgement dated November 29th, 2010

Mumbai, November 30, 2010: A Reliance Communications (RCOM) spokesperson made the following statement today in the interests of the Company's over 2 million shareholders:

RCOM official spokesperson:

- 1. "The matter before the Supreme Court relates to the year 2004, prior to the reorganisation of the Reliance group, and an amount of Rs. 9.14 crore claimed by BSNL under the interconnect agreement with RCOM.
- 2. The Hon'ble Supreme Court has held that there is no penalty under the interconnect agreement, and only a pre-estimate of reasonable compensation to BSNL.
- 3. The Supreme Court has remanded the matter to TDSAT to decide the matter de novo in accordance with the interpretation laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- 4. RCOM doesn't anticipate any material liability as a result of the judgment.
- 5. The Supreme Court judgment will be applicable to the entire telecom industry, since all operators have interconnection agreements with BSNL having similar provisions."
